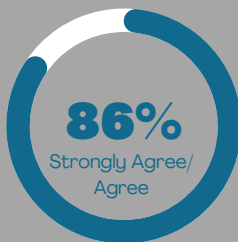


# Annual SURVEY 2021



Respondents included a wide range of job roles, districts and Fams events attended.

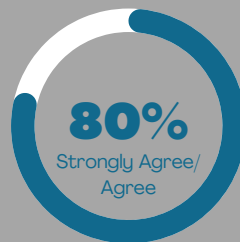
## AWARENESS

0.3% Strongly Disagree

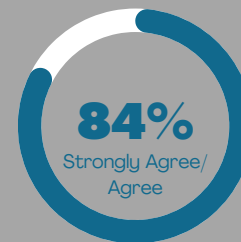
## ENGAGEMENT

0.3% Strongly Disagree

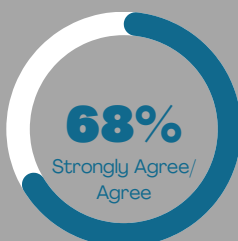
## INFORMED

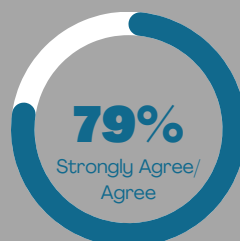
## OPINION
