## Accessibility

The Aerial is a disability accessible venue, with lifts, ramps and an accessible bathroom on site. A hearing induction loop is also available on request.

## Remote and Regional Scholarships

Fams is committed to supporting our rural, remote and regional colleagues attend our conference. We reinvest our registration fees into our scholarship programs.

#### **Parking and Transportation**

Paid parking is available on-site at the <u>Interpark UTS Car Park</u>. Enter from Thomas St (travelling west) and a lift to the function centre is accessible from the car park.

Limited metered street parking is available on Thomas Street.

Aerial is a 5-minute walk from Central Railway Station and 15 minutes to the Sydney CBD. Public buses run regularly between UTS and the city.

Sydney airport is a 30-minute drive (allow for traffic).
